

# GLITTER HEART BOX

## Glitter:

- Micro-fine Opaque: #502 Diva Gold
- Ultra-fine Opaque: #23 Periwinkle
- Vintage Glass Glitter, Fine:  
#609 Grape Arbor, #608 Red Damask,  
#616 Primrose
- Vintage Glass Glitter, Shards:  
#906 Carnelian

## Materials:

- Brush Marker: Gold
- Cardboard Heart Shaped Box,  
approx. 3 1/2" wide
- Designer Dries Clear Adhesive With  
Ultrafine Metal Tip Attached
- Jar
- Plastic trays or creased paper or  
coffee filter
- Paint Brush
- Spoon



## Box Directions:

Pour approximately 1 ounce of adhesive into jar. Pour glitter into trays or set on a piece of creased paper or coffee filter to catch excess glitter.

Color inside lid of box with brush marker including the sides and rim. Optional: for total coverage, color the outside bottom of box too.

Brush glue on outside of lid. Start with the sides working with one side of the heart at a time to make sure glue does not begin drying. Try not to get any glue/glitter on the inside rim of lid. It will scrape against the bottom of box when you close it. Spoon on micro-fine gold glitter, tap off extra glitter. Glue and glitter other side of lid. Set aside to dry.

Brush glue on inside bottom of box. Cover floor first then spoon on gold glitter, slide glitter along wet glue until it is covered. Pour out and tap off excess. Brush glue onto inner side of box walls, working with half of the heart at a time. Spoon on gold glitter and slide it along wet glue while pouring it out. Glue and glitter other side of box. Set aside to dry.

Brush glue on top of lid. Work quickly to make sure glue is wet, white and shiny to accept the glitter properly. Cover with gold glitter. Set aside to dry. Touch-test the inside of box to make sure it is dry. When dry, glue and glitter outside walls of box in the same manner, working with half of the heart at a time.

## Embellishing Lid:

In the middle of the lid draw a 2" heart and fill it in with the adhesive bottle and metal tip attached. Spoon on red shards glass glitter, tap off excess. While glue is still wet, spoon on red fine glass glitter to fill in background of heart. Make glue dots around edge of lid approx. 1/16" apart, work in 2" sections at a time, then spoon on pink fine glass glitter. Continue around lid. Make more glue dots in between pink dots and sprinkle with purple fine glass glitter.

Once red heart is dry, draw a small heart inside of it with glue, filled in generously, then cover it with ultra-fine blue glitter. Frame outside of red heart with glue dots sprinkled with blue glitter. Then make glue dots around the inside of pink and purple glass heart frame and sprinkle with blue glitter. Set aside to dry, about 15 minutes.

Glue some random dots inside red heart and spoon on pink glass glitter. Make some random purple glass glitter dots too.

Embellish the sides of the lid with blue glitter lines. Start at bottom of the side and make a dot, without lifting tip, pull adhesive up to top of lid to create a tear-drop line, make lines about 1/8" apart, working in 2" sections, sprinkle with blue glitter. Set aside to dry.
