



VALENTINE NAPKIN CARDS

Glitter:

- Ultra-fine Opaque: #23 Periwinkle, #65 Old Gold, #67 Fools Gold, #117 Leaf

Materials:

- Brush Marker: color of your choice
- Designer Dries Clear Adhesive With Ultrafine Metal Tip
- Heart Shaped Napkins, approx. 5" wide, red
- Plastic trays or creased paper or coffee filter
- Spoon

"Valentine" Directions:

Pour glitter into trays or set on a piece of creased paper or coffee filter to catch excess glitter.

NOTE: A square napkin can be cut into a heart shape for this project. Just make sure it is a high quality brand so that it does not fray when applying the adhesive. Don't forget to leave part of the fold in tack when cutting a shape out.

With the fold on the left, draw a small heart at the top of napkin below the heart's point and spoon on blue glitter. Then draw a vine pattern around the napkin with adhesive, working in 2" sections at a time to keep glue wet, white and shiny. Spoon on green glitter. Make random glue dots along the vine, sprinkle with blue glitter. Continue in same manner to make gold and green dots along the vine. Set aside to dry.

With glue and tip attached, write "Valentine" at an angle inside vine frame. Sprinkle with Fools Gold. Make three small random glue hearts around sentiment and sprinkle with blue glitter.

Once dry, personalize or write a sentiment inside card with adhesive and glitter of your choice or use a brush marker.

"Be Mine" Directions:

This napkin is done much the same way as "Valentine" card.

Create gold frame around heart by making "squiggly" glue lines. Start with one half of the design, drawing half circles end to end, back and forth until half of heart is done. Sprinkle with Old Gold. Continue around rest of heart. Then draw opposite sides of circles with adhesive and cover with Fools Gold. Set aside to dry.

With glue and tip attached, write "Be Mine" at an angle inside squiggly frame. Sprinkle with blue glitter. Make evenly spaced glue dots on either side of frame and sprinkle with blue glitter.

Once dry, personalize or write a sentiment inside card with adhesive and glitter of your choice or use a brush marker.
